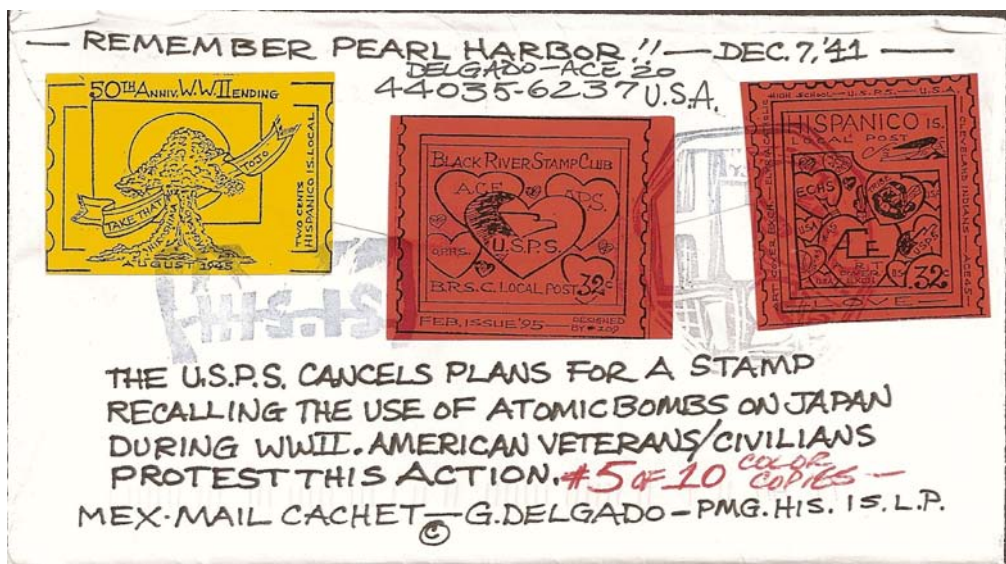
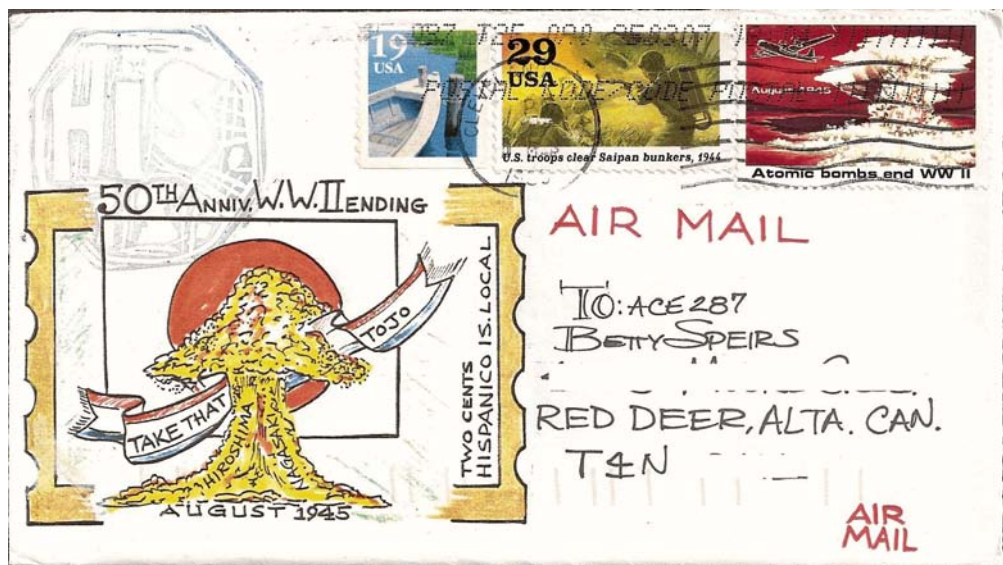

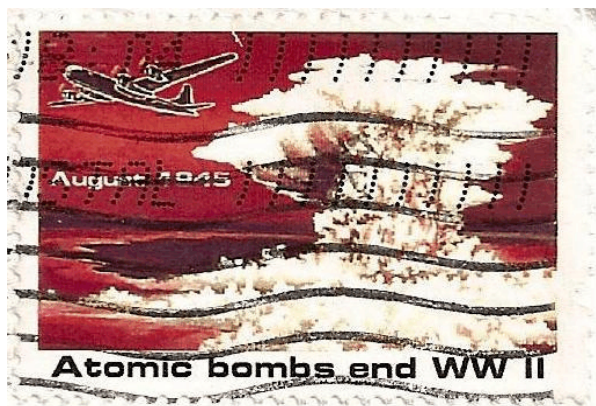

THE WAR IS OVER! AND SO WERE THE STAMPS

In late 1994, the United States Postal Service announced the designs for a set of stamps celebrating the end of World War Two. One of them was a mushroom cloud with the title "Atomic bombs hasten war's end, August 1945". The Japanese government protested and President Bill Clinton kowtowed to them, ordering a replacement stamp showing Harry Truman and the inscription "Truman announces Japan's surrender, Aug. 14, 1945".

This set off a counter protest by Americans. Gerry Newhouse and Ron Kaplan produced and sold a cinderella label depicting the rejected design with revised inscriptions. They were popular among mail artists. My mother, the late Betty Speirs, belonged to the Art Cover Exchange group of mail artists (still active, visit www.artcoverexchange.org). A couple of her American correspondents sent her envelopes with atomic protests.



The front cover of this bulletin shows both sides of one such protest envelope from an Ohio mail artist G. Delgado, using the Newhouse/Kaplan label.

Figure 1 (left) shows an enlarged view of the label. Figure 2 (below) is a mailing from a Salem, Oregon, mail artist.



MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

I'd like to thank all of you for your support over the past two years. I'd especially like to acknowledge the efforts of the Board Members and Committee Chairs as well as many others who have made dedicated efforts to the smooth operation of the CPS. The CPS is fortunate to have a great group of individuals and we want to work hard to celebrate our 100-year anniversary in 2022.

MID-MONTH AUCTION SEPTEMBER 16

While the September 2 AGM has been cancelled, it is intended there will be a mid-month auction at the Kerby Centre on September 16. The Kerby Centre has several entry controls and requires renting organizations such as ours to follow specific procedures. All visitors complete a brief questionnaire and undergo a temperature check at the entry area. In our meeting room all attendees must sign in (bring your own pen or pencil). Hand sanitizer will be available. All individuals must wear masks while in the Kerby Centre.

There is a capacity limit of 40 for our meeting room so if there is an unusually heavy attendance, we may have to limit access. Those wishing to only view the circuit books, which will be available are asked to depart after having done so. Please use hand sanitizer after handling any of the auction lots.

Auction lots will be placed on tables arranged along the walls and the stage so that they will be viewed from only one side. All members are to remain 2 metres apart at all times. Following normal viewing members will be asked to position chairs at least 2 metres apart. Only lots with two bids will be auctioned.

ZOOM MEETINGS

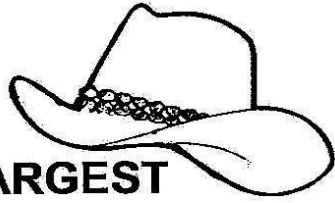
