SYNOPSIS

Purpose of the Exhibit

The Canada Official Postal Guide(s) (COPG) 1936-1937, 1938-1939, 1940-1941 provide details of items considered to be and are accepted for transmission as 3rd Class Matter for which the postal rate was set at 1¢ per 2 ounces or fraction thereof for both domestic and international mailings.

Research / Preparation

Research / Preparation is all "secondary" in nature limited to examination of the COPGs.

The exhibit is restricted to single use of the 1¢ Mufti.

The exhibit considers 3rd Class Matter only. Articles of 2nd Class Matter (Newspapers and Periodicals) (COPG 38, 39 & 40) are not considered in this exhibit.

This exhibit has been modified following presentation at the annual conventions of the Canadian Philatelic Society of Great Britain and the "Fall Regional" of the Calgary Philatelic Society.
