CANADIAN MAIL, THE POST OFFICE AND COVID-19

COVID-19 distrupted not only life styles in Canada but the Post Office in many ways. Early in March 2020 all guarantees of mail delivery was suspended. The request for signatures for items on receipt of the item was abolished on all but Registered Mail. Mail to a number of countries was totally abolished or certain types of mail and/or parcels were restricted. These regulations changed at least 3 times These restricted items were eventually returned to the sender, with a label which we show. Sometimes this took 6 months to arrive back to the sender.

The volume of parcels increased dramatically as people shopped on line. Some mail processing plants were closed for a period of time because of Covid-19 within the plant. For instance, sometime in April the Calgary sorting plant shut down for 2 weeks. A package sent to me from Edmonton was send to Calgary then forwarded to Toronto and returned to Southern Alberta. Letters and parcel delivery became erratic with items taking 3 days to 6 weeks to cover the same territory.

We show mail from Canadian Charities, Care Providers and others with COVED-19 related pictures and themes.

Canada Post provided a special cancel at 11 sorting plants on many different machines – all the same wording but with different type styles, thanking Healthcare Workers.

Canada Post gave each employee before Christmas a pretty cardboard box containing a thank you card and pin plus 3 booklets of 12 special stamps thanking them for their extraordinary services. All had the same basic design. Postal Stationery Cards and Illustrated Permit mail from Canada Post this Christmas referred to difficult or unusual times.

Finally, we show a selection of many of the signs related COVID-19 precautions found in the Post Office lobbies.
