

SYNOPSIS : Cancelled by COVID-19 in Canada

Purpose:

This exhibit shows the covers, stamps and cancels that have been made in Canada, or related to Canada, throughout the pandemic starting in March 2020 through March 2022. The exhibit is Not trying to show information and facts on Covid itself. The exhibit is more of a historical record as opposed to anything else.

Challenge Factor:

Except for the Canada Post items like the Employee Thank You Booklet, WriteMe cards and the Post Office collector and Business Thank You cards which were printed in the thousands, most of the other special items were produced in quantities ranging from 3 to 50. In many cases the quantities issued are shown in the exhibit. More items are likely to be found in the coming year possibly as this exhibit is shown at various shows.

This exhibit will likely grow beyond where it is today as the pandemic will likely continue with additional waves or events that may warrant commemoration.

This Covid story is shown in chronological order. Items that are repetitive with dates are not included.
